

How will the project be delivered?

Because of the scale of the project, it is the intention of the PCC to complete the work in phases; each phase to be completed before moving onto the next.

These phases have been determined in consultation with our Architect and his team.

The overriding factors in ensuring that each phase is completed are having the finance in position and the correct permission to proceed with the work from the authorities responsible.

What is the next step?

To date we have refurbished the small kitchen at the back of the church. Now we are looking to complete the next phase. This includes: -

- Replacing and renewing the existing heating system
- Repairing the roof on the southside of the church
- Creating the classroom/meeting room in organ chamber
- Installing a new electronic organ
- Carpet the main church meeting room and install 200 comfortable chairs.

The next phases will follow on the completion of the above.

- Build external extension creating hall, reception and toilet facilities
- Screen off part of church to provide a large meeting room which will also serve as a meet and greet area as well as a crèche during weekly worship
- Furnish commercial kitchen built in the new extension
- Glaze in chancel creating a small chapel and meeting room

The hope of the PCC is that you will get behind the project and help us onto the next phase.

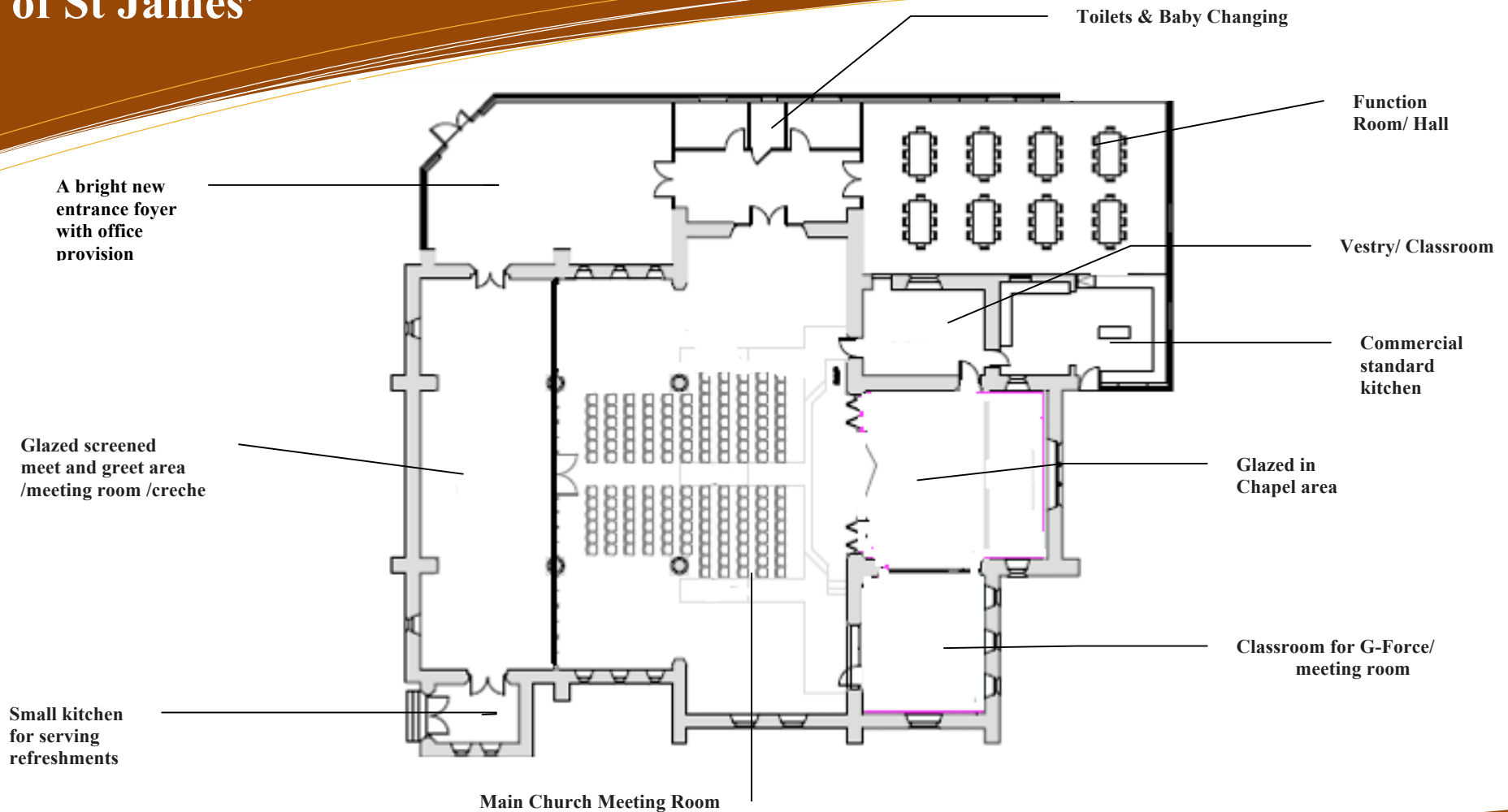
Building the Beacon
